BOUT THE SEMINAR

The Malaysian Standard MS ISO 37001:2016 Anti Bribery Management Systems was launched by the Department of Standards Malaysia in Putrajaya on the 27 October 2017. This standard is identical with that published by the International Organization for Standardization (ISO). The aim of the standard is to help organisations in implementing reasonable and proportionate measures to prevent, detect and respond to bribery.

Prior to the MS ISO 37001:2016, 21 initiatives have also been identified under the Construction Industry Transformation Programme (CITP) 2016-2020 to be implemented under 4 strategic thrusts. Among the CITP initiatives that is in line with MS ISO 37001:2016, is Initiative Q5 that is to enhance integrity and increase governance in the construction industry. Under this initiative, 3 key performance indicators (KPI) have been identified to support the implementation of Initiative Q5, one of the 3 KPIs being 10 construction related organisations/local authorities to be certified with ISO 37001/MS ISO 37001 (Anti-Bribery Management Systems) by 2020. Whilst more than 10 construction industry organisations may eventually adopt the standard to assist them in complying with the legal obligations and commitment to integrity, this seminar will serve as a platform to introduce MS ISO 37001:2016 to industry players.

Organisations in the construction industry have a responsibility to proactively contribute to combating bribery towards enhancing integrity and increasing governance. It is hoped that this seminar will enlighten participants on the importance of having an anti-bribery policy and supporting management system leading to many more industry organisations that will adopt the MS ISO 37001:2016

This seminar is targeted at construction related industry players and is jointly organised by the Department of Standards Malaysia, CIDB Malaysia and Malaysian Anti Corruption Commission.
